The stables encompasses over 90 acres, two miles west of the Town of Six Mile off Old Seneca Road in Pickens County, just 15 minutes from downtown Clemson and 30 miles west of Greenville.

Kings Groves Stables is an Equine Management Certified farm.

The property consists of:

- *35 acres in pasture (divided into 16 separate pastures with shelters)*
- *smooth wire electric fencing*
- *two hour riding trails*
- *three arenas & one round pen*
- *two barns with electricity & city water*
- *a shelter for meetings, picnics, or gatherings*

We believe our facilities are very adequate for your horse. Someone on our staff will observe your horse each day. Any obvious problem will be reported.

The owner is the most important factor in the care of your horse.

We have a veterinarian to perform spring and fall shots, and a coggins is required.

Pasture Board:

- Horses remain in the pasture, sheds available during foul weather
- Hay, water and minerals provided free choice

Boarders are expected to worm horses every two months.

Kings Grove Stables is located two miles west of the Town of Six Mile on Old Seneca Road, within a 15 minute drive from Central, Keowee Key, Clemson and Seneca.

There are two separate barns that include stalls, sheds and paddocks. A feed room and tack rooms are at each barn, as are electricity and city water. Both barns are well lit and have security lights. A restroom is located in Barn 2.

The stables property includes over 90 acres. There are 16 separate pastures in lots of approximately two acres. This allows small groups of horses in each lot which facilitates more efficient management of grazing areas. Small lots also make it easier to catch the horses. The grazing areas are drug for manure piles and are mowed periodically. The fences are smooth wire with an electric charge.

Three show rings are available on the farm and a 72 foot round pen is near one barn. The third arena is for dressage and is located near the creek. Two arenas have lights. Riding trails on the property provide a chance to work the horse and enjoy the area. The Issaqueena Trails of Clemson University are just two miles away.
